

Dear Parishioners,

Today's Gospel poses two questions that are surprisingly hard for many of us to answer.

First: What are we good at?

The second question: What are we doing with that talent?

My friends, no one of us is a total disaster; we aren't completely empty of any skills or (to use the Gospel word) "talents." We may not be able to perform brain surgery, but we can comfort a child just stung by a bee. We may not be a CEO, but when customers leave our checkout line they're a bit happier and lighter in spirit because of the warm way we treated them.

In fact, if we can make a living off our talent and skill, terrific — but how are we contributing the good we possess to make the Kingdom of God a reality here and now? To keep our "talents" to ourselves is a betrayal of God's trust; to act as if we have nothing to contribute is an act of ingratitude to the God who gave those skills and abilities to us.

So what has god entrusted to you — and that's the word: entrusted.

What has god invested in you for the good of the world?

We seldom see the question that way. We're taught how to put a price on whatever talents and skills we possess, translating our knowledge and abilities into successful careers.

Or we're overwhelmed with a false sense of humility: we don't think our gifts are worth all that much to begin with, so we keep them to ourselves for our own amusement or diversion.

But today's parable challenges us to see whatever "talents" we possess — be they the ability to manage a big organization or the quiet patience to heal a hurting child — as a scared trust.

My friends, our lives will be judged by how we used our "talents," whether earth moving or quietly

healing, to realize god's kingdom of mercy and justice in our time and place.

May God our Father give you Grace and peace!

## Readings of the Week

### Reading I: Proverbs 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31

The wise woman receives her reward.

- The poem of the first reading is the conclusion of the Book of Proverbs.
- It is very likely that the poem is about both a good wife and Wisdom herself.
- The whole poem highlights the point that whoever finds Wisdom does indeed find life.

### Reading II: <u>1 Thessalonians 5:1-6</u>

You are children of the light.

- The Thessalonians were caught between worry over the imminent return of Christ and the complacency in their faith.
- Paul instructed them to be diligent in preparing, but not to worry.
- Christians are children of light.

### Gospel: Matthew 25:14-30

We must use the gifts we have been given!

- The Gospel reading deals with the end of the world and the coming of God's Kingdom.
- The paradox of today's parable is that the one who played it safe lost while, in the end, the risk-takers gained.
- Faithfulness implies not only keeping the tradition but also the willingness to risk everything in order to increase God's Kingdom.

### Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflection

- .The Gospel today asks us to use our gifts and risk everything for the sake of the Gospel. Give a cardboard circle to each member of the family. Instruct each person to write his or her name on a circle and then to pass the circle to the person on the left. This person should write on the circle one gift that the family member has. If the children are too young to write, do this orally while someone in the family writes. Take time to affirm the talents you see in one another. Talk about ways to use your gifts to help build God's Kingdom.
- Explore the service opportunities available in your community. Discuss with your family ways that you can use your gifts to make life better for someone less fortunate.
- Discuss with your family what risks you can take this week to spread the Gospel values to those we meet in our everyday life.


