

Message from Fr. Steve Pinzon, Parochial Vicar

Dear Parishioners,

April in the Catholic calendar is considered the month of the Holy Eucharist. Sadly, we as a community have not, under these relatively unprecedented circumstances, gathered with Holy Mass for this most august and beautiful sacrament of our religion.

Nevertheless, moments like these can bring out another side of our spiritual lives unknown to us, but still very life-giving and important. It is a time to learn how to "pray without ceasing" and to pray in "our rooms" to the Father, as Christ taught us. To "stand beneath the Cross" as did the Blessed Mother in contemplation and hopefulness for the Resurrection to come. To "walk by faith and not by sight" and allow ourselves to be guided and instructed by the "Christ who strengthens me", as St. Paul shares with us.

In other words, *practicing the presence of God* in our daily lives -- in our thoughts, words, actions and relationships. The Saints advocated to always have a *spiritual communion* with the Holy Eucharist and bringing Him into us so to be given to others.

The following prayer by Pope Francis, during this trying time of pandemic, mentions the *Miracle at Cana*, which was Christ's first miracle and a prefigurement of the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper. It is placed in the perspective of Mary, his Mother, as she, in spiritual communion, watches always over us, as she watched over her Son. Let us, then, learn from her who is our model of prayer and the model of the Church. And may we keep close to Jesus of Nazareth, the Name that is "above all other names", and as He called himself, our Good Shepherd and Bread of Life.

O Mary, you shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope.

We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick.

At the foot of the Cross you participated in Jesus' pain, with steadfast faith.

You, Salvation of the Roman People, know what we need.

We are certain that you will provide, so that, as you did at Cana of Galilee, joy and feasting might return after this moment of trial.

Help us, Mother of Divine Love, to conform ourselves to the Father's will and to do what Jesus tells us: He who took our sufferings upon Himself, and bore our sorrows to bring us, through the Cross, to the joy of the Resurrection. Amen.

We seek refuge under your protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our pleas – we who are put to the test – and deliver us from every danger, O glorious and blessed Virgin.

To note as well, Fr. Wallace and I are offering the sacrifice of the Mass for you and for the particular intention asked of us. The Mass is first and foremost a sacerdotal or priestly prayer made in intercession for all God's people and the Church. May you feel God's presence, then, even from a distance. And may we say together in honor of the Blessed Sacrament and Holy Eucharist, "O Sacrament most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine!"

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflections

5th Sunday of Lent

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- God wants us to live and to enjoy the world and people around us. Give each family member a small slip of paper. Have each person write down one thing that keeps him or her from enjoying life. When ready, invite family members to quietly place the slip of paper in a garbage can. Pray a little prayer to thank Jesus for calling you back to life.
- Plant seeds with your child to help him or her understand death and new life. If planting indoors, fill a plastic container with potting soil. After planting the seeds, talk with your child about watering the seeds and watching for growth. Even though the seeds will die in the soil, they will also reappear in a new form, as a new plant. Explain that the seeds are a symbol of the new life that Jesus gives.
- Talk about ways to bring new life to your town or neighborhood. What can your family do to help achieve this? Make a plan and carry it out.




