Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Parishioners,

Today's first reading from Acts exhorts us to pray – to talk to our God. We need to pray with confidence - like the disciples in the upper room who prayed for the coming of the Holy Spirit, we, too, must pray with that same confidence. We must also pray not just individually but also as a community. And, if our prayer is not answered immediately we should continue to pray with persistence. When we pray this way, we are aware of what God is able to accomplish through us and not what we are able to do on our own. The disciples also prayed as if everything depended on God and nothing on themselves. Sometimes, the only time we pray is when we have a problem and we need God to take care of it. In so doing, we must be mindful of Matthew's gospel where we are told to ask and it will be given; seek and we will find; and knock and it will be opened. Luke's gospel also reminds us that we pray always and not give up. So, let's remember to keep on praying even if we don't feel like it and even if we feel as though God is not listening. Guess what? He is!

In the reading of St. John 10:10 we hear Jesus say: "I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly." From this statement, we can assume that to have eternal life is to be fully alive. Eternal life is quite different from everlasting life. The devil and his angels have everlasting life which simply means that they will never die. Jesus, on the other hand, promised those who were faithful to him a life eternal, which is a life of perfect union with God and in God. Therefore, we might surmise that to have eternal life is to be fully alive.

In today's Gospel, Jesus shows us the way to eternal life when he tells us: "And this is eternal life that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent" (John 17:3). When we know someone, we have a personal and intimate relationship with them. So, the knowledge of God, which leads us to eternal life is relational rather than intellectual. Jesus tells us that eternal life lies in recognizing that there is only one true God, the God that he calls Father. Today, we are faced with many gods, but eternal life asks two things of us: that we know the Father, the only true God and Jesus Christ whom he sent.

We are all looking for a long life and, of course, the good life. Eternal life is the unending good life. We are able to attain this if we pray and develop a personal relationship with God and with his Son, Jesus, whom he sent so that we might know his Father and our Father.

YEAR OF MERCY

Dear Parishioners,

As we move forward in the “Year of Mercy”, I ask you to consider the words of Jesus, *“When I was thirsty you gave me to drink”*.

Can you answer “yes” to this question?

Can you see Jesus in those you encounter daily?

Can you see Jesus in those who are less fortunate?

In our everyday lives, we take clean water and so many other needs for granted, needs that our brothers and sisters in this country and in other countries throughout the world can only “dream” about. In many countries the local river water is used to bathe, to wash, and as drinking water. The luxury of having running water does not even enter into the picture. Yet...

WATER is such a basic need. About two-thirds of the human body is made up of water. Our bodies that have been so wonderfully designed by God are able to go without food for a longer period of time than they can without water. Water is a need we all have and we all possess. The need of the poor is no different than the need of the not so poor.

In the summer of 2016, farm workers on South Jersey farms in the Camden Diocese will work the land and harvest the crops. The Diocese has a farm ministry that reaches out to the migrant workers to provide them with basic needs. One need that the farm workers have is for bottled water when working in the fields in the hot sun. As our June act of Mercy can we help to alleviate this need? Can we offer them a drink of water?

On Sunday, June 12 please consider helping our farm workers with bottled water. You can bring in a 6, 12 or 24 pkg. of bottled water to mass with you. ***At Assumption Church please bring the water to Kelly Hall before the start of Mass. At St. Ann Church please bring the water to the front steps of the church.** If you would prefer to make a monetary donation please write a check to NDDL Parish and put the word WATER in the memo area. **There will be envelopes in the rear of church for these checks.**

Misericordiae Vultus

Just as our thoughts and prayers have turned to Mary during the month of May, so too, our Holy Father Francis now turns to Mary, our Mother, and begs her intercession for each one of us as we journey through this extraordinary Year of Mercyand so.... we wish *countless graces, mercies, blessings and indulgences of this extraordinary Holy Year of Mercy to all who are persevering to reflect seriously, engage prayerfully and act boldly on Pope Francis' letter which challenge us in very unique ways to be “Merciful like the Father”*. (MV14)

Pope Francis continues“My thoughts now turn to the Mother of Mercy. May the sweetness of her countenance watch over us in this Holy Year, so that all of us may rediscover the joy of God’s tenderness. No one has penetrated the profound mystery of the incarnation like Mary. Her entire life was patterned after the presence of mercy made flesh. The Mother of the Crucified and Risen One has entered the sanctuary of divine mercy because she participated intimately in the mystery of His love.

Chosen to be the Mother of the Son of God, Mary, from the onset, was prepared by the love of God to be the Ark of the Covenant between God and man. She treasured divine mercy in her heart in perfect harmony with her Son Jesus. Her hymn of praise, sung at the threshold of the home of Elizabeth, was dedicated to the mercy of God which extends from “generation to generation” (Lk 1:50). We too were included in those prophetic words of Mary. This will be a source of comfort and strength to us as we cross the threshold of the Holy Year to experience the fruits of divine mercy.

At the foot of the Cross, Mary, together with John, the disciple of love, witnessed the words of forgiveness spoken by Jesus. This supreme expression of mercy towards those who crucified him shows us the point to which the mercy of God can reach. Mary attests that the mercy of the Son of God knows no bounds and extends to everyone, without exception. Let us address her in the words of the *Salve Regina*, a prayer ever ancient and ever new, so that she may never tire of turning her merciful eyes upon us, and make us worthy to contemplate the face of mercy, her Son Jesus.

Our prayer also extends to the saints and the blessed ones who made divine mercy their mission in life. I think especially of the great apostle of mercy, Saint Faustina Kowalska. May she, who was called to enter the depths of divine mercy, intercede for us and obtain for us the grace of living and walking always according to the mercy of God and with an unwavering trust in his love.” (MV 24)
