# Letter From Father Yvans

#### Dear Parishioners,

It has been seven months since you have been praying for my mother. I want to thank you all for your prayers and your support during the time that my mother was sick. On June 16, 2016 the Lord called her to her eternal rest. My mother was a friend and a prayer warrior. Through your prayers she was a able to fight the sickness for a longer time than expected. The effect of your prayers either personal or in community has reached heaven. Through you, I regained courage to continue on as we often read in the letter of Paul to the Roman 8:35-37 "Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us". As I usually say before I start my homily "God is good all the time". It does not take much effort for everyone to make this statement. However, there is a great truth in it. Knowing the magnitude of the words expressed, life experiences always lead us to exercise the full meaning of this statement. You were really a good Samaritan to me and my family during that time. Some of you even went further to go see her in Haiti. This is what the gospel is teaching us this Sunday. Sometimes we need to look to the other side of the road to support, to help out, to teach and to heal with our prayers and with good deeds.

I want to express my heart felt gratitude to all of you for being a good Samaritan on the road of the Farm workers ministry. You played an excellent part to make this ministry a great success. I want to thank AnnaMae for helping to put everything together to get water, soda, and money to purchase the necessary tools and pay a musician to make the mass at the farm a blessing for the Farm workers. This is what the book of Deuteronomy

reminds us this weekend that God not only gives His commandments in the Holy scriptures, but that they are also written in our hearts, so that we may obey them and inherit eternal life with God. In the second reading, Saint Paul reminds the Colossians and us, that just as Christ Jesus is the visible image of the invisible God, so our neighbors are the visible image of Christ living in our midst. In the Gospel Jesus redirected the scribe as he redirects all of us to see him in our neighbors because the parable indicates that a "neighbor" is anyone who needs help.

Let us remember that the road from Jerusalem to Jericho passes right through our home, parish, school and work place. When we show compassion for our brothers and sisters, we express the commandment that Jesus, who is the heavenly good Samaritan, teaches us in the Gospel (John 13, 34) during the last Supper: "Love one another as I have Loved you", because the invisible God dwells in every human being. Let us accept the invitation to be loving and merciful to our brothers and sisters.



#### **Hands for Jesus**

As we go about our daily activities we sometimes fail to stop and think about the most important action of the day. When we are receiving the Eucharist do we think about what condi-

tion our hands are in or what condition our hearts are in? As we receive the Eucharist today we come forward with open heart and open mind to receive the Lord with open hands. We make a throne for the Lord with our hands. A throne by placing our non-dominant hand on top of our dominant hand. The Eucharistic minister or the priest then has a place to gently place Our Lord. From that position we accept the Lord by immediately placing the host in our mouth. Returning to your place, it is time to spend a few moments speaking to the Lord in your heart. (Please do not try to take the host from the minister or the priest's hand. The rules of the church ask that host be placed in your hand where you are then to pick it up and consume it.)
