Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Parishioners,

As we all know from our experiences, there are many kinds of prayers and many reasons for praying. Sometimes we pray because we are in need, and need God's help. Sometimes we pray because we are grateful for favors, or for an answer to prayers we have offered for a special intention. Still other times we pray for forgiveness for something we have done or failed to do. And then, there are those times we pray because we want to worship and honor our God.

No matter what the reason is for which we pray, today's first reading encourages us to be persistent (like Abraham in our first reading for today), to keep on asking and not to give up. Let's pause for a moment and ask ourselves, honestly: how often do we pray and for what do we pray? These two questions lead us to our Gospel of today where Jesus teaches us how to pray. The prayer, of course is the *Our Father*, the Lord's prayer which contains many reasons for praying. Jesus, first of all, encouraged us to call God, Father; to honor his name and to pray for the kingdom; also not to be afraid to be human and pray for our daily bread. He continues with the fact that we ask for forgiveness for our sins; as well as forgiving others as God forgives us. This prayer also reminds us that we need to talk with God like we would talk with a close friend. In other words Jesus is encouraging us to keep asking; keep searching; and keep knocking. God will hear our prayers and will answer them (maybe not as we expect them to be answered), but will He definitely answer them.

In order to approach our God in prayer, we must rid ourselves of all biases and prejudices. We must trust that God will give us what we need. Are we willing to trust that God will hear our prayers, no matter how unimportant they may seem to us? We must remember, always, that he is our Father, and our friend; that he knows what we need and what is good for us. Are we willing to pray for that person in our lives with whom we are angry or hurt? In other words are we willing to bury the hatchet? Are we willing to seek forgiveness from someone with whom we are estranged? Are we willing to bring into our lives, our homes, our community, those who are neglected, ill-treated, marginalized or even strangers?

Year of Mercy

Dear Parishioners,

God our Almighty Father is the protector of all. Last January Fr. Yvans, Fr. Wallace and a group of parishioners went to Haiti on a Mission Trip. They saw firsthand that most of the people living in Haiti lack many of the basic daily items. During the months of August and September, the "Mercy Team" has decided to ask the parish to help our brothers and sisters in Haiti with some of their basic needs in keeping with the Corporal and Spiritual Acts of Mercy.

<u>August</u> -For the past two summers the Summer Intensive Program has collected school supplies for the children in Haiti. This year the request for school supplies will be extended to the parish at large. As a teacher for many years I saw many a pencil on the floor of a classroom and pens being dismantled to play with in class, the children in Haiti treat these with respect since they often only own one and it has a real need and purpose in they're lives. Please bring in the school supplies on the Sundays of August 7th, and August 14th and place them in the containers provided.

<u>September</u> – The Sisters of Mercy were known as the 'walking nuns'. They were the first nuns to leave their convent and go out to the people in their homes, hospitals and prisons were the need was great. Therefore the boots are a symbol of the work that the sisters were able to do in their communities. Boots today are commonly worn in the winter but not in warm weather or warm climates. Therefore, we make a transfer here to meet the people of Haiti as well. We look especially here at the need for footwear of the children. The children in Haiti will soon begin school. They are not permitted to attend school in Haiti without having a pair of shoes. All summer they were allowed to run the streets in their bare feet but to receive an education shoes are required. Therefore, I suggest the purchase of shoes, sneakers are fine. All children sizes of sneakers and shoes are welcome. In this case we only ask that they be new. In the shipping process it takes weeks to get to Haiti and used shoes can build up an odor in shipment therefore new shoes are requested. The shoes should be brought to the church sites on September 4th, and September 11th and placed in the marked containers.

If you prefer to make a financial donation to Haiti please write a check to Notre Dame de la Mer parish and in the memo portion of the check please put the word "HAITI". These check donations will be tallied and one check will be sent to the orphanage in Haiti in the name of the parish.

Thank you in advance for taking care of the needs of the least of our brothers and sisters.


