Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Friends,

Are we ready to enter or pass through the narrow gate? Do we have our homes (souls) in order? Will we be saved if we are unable to pass through the narrow gate? The answer to this question is “no”. Some other questions we might ask ourselves are: am I a Catholic in name only? Do I strive, daily, to follow Jesus? Do I receive him in the Eucharist, as worthily as possible? Do I need to go to confession so that I will not be turned away from entering through the narrow gate?

We must sit at the table of Jesus Christ and eat in the Church that Jesus Christ established. Jesus promised Peter that he would build “my Church”; not their churches. Jesus instituted the Catholic Church as One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic. We have chosen to enter through the narrow door which is symbolic of poverty; having a charitable heart; forgiving others; being patient; kind and considerate of others; talking about Jesus; accepting crosses (joyfully) when they come our way. Let us not be followers of modern trends – let us follow Jesus’ way and not our own way.

If you remember a few weeks ago, the Gospel parable according to Luke was about a man who had gone to bed; bolted his door and was asleep when he was awakened from his sleep by a neighbor who was persistent to obtain the bread that he needed for his company. Today’s gospel leads us to believe that we might keep on knocking and asking but the Master will not open the door. It is at this time, that we must increase our prayers and petitions and allow God’s mercy to take effect in our lives. The past several week’s gospels invite us to follow Jesus and minister to the poor. He further calls us to give alms to the poor; when engaged in confrontation, turn the other cheek; walk the extra mile with someone who needs our help; and love our enemies. We might also contribute to a favorite charity, without employing consumer and/or capitalist values. Instead, maybe we could follow Jesus’ teaching by “selling all we have and giving to the poor, and then following him. Luke is asking us to follow Jesus even if his exhortations or commands seem unreasonable; since he is not asking anything of us that he, himself has not already done.

How wide is the door of our Christian commitment? Do I accept others’ cultural values? How narrow is the door of our Christian commitment? Am I committed to self-giving? Will the Lord treat us as he did the visitor who claimed to the owner of the house that he had eaten and drank with him? And the owner of the house had no recollection of him. Jesus, like the householder, doesn’t remember acquaintances, social connections, nor birth rights. None of these claims will admit us through the narrow gate.

Perhaps our first reading today is the answer we need. In this reading, God promises to gather all nations in Jerusalem where all people will recognize God’s glory. Am I willing to walk through the narrow gate?

Year of Mercy

Dear Parishioners,

God our Almighty Father is the protector of all. Last January Fr. Yvans, Fr. Wallace and a group of parishioners went to Haiti on a Mission Trip. They saw firsthand that most of the people living in Haiti lack many of the basic daily items. During the month of September, the "Mercy Team" has decided to ask the parish to help our brothers and sisters in Haiti with some of their basic needs in keeping with the Corporal and Spiritual Acts of Mercy.

September – The Sisters of Mercy were known as the 'walking nuns'. They were the first nuns to leave their convent and go out to the people in their homes, hospitals and prisons where the need was great. Therefore the boots are a symbol of the work that the sisters were able to do in their communities. Boots today are commonly worn in the winter but not in warm weather or warm climates. Therefore, we make a transfer here to meet the people of Haiti as well. We look especially here at the need for footwear of the children. The children in Haiti will soon begin school. They are not permitted to attend school in Haiti without having a pair of shoes. All summer they were allowed to run the streets in their bare feet but to receive an education shoes are required. Therefore, I suggest the purchase of shoes, sneakers are fine. All children sizes of sneakers and shoes are welcome. In this case we only ask that they be new. In the shipping process it takes weeks to get to Haiti and used shoes can build up an odor in shipment therefore new shoes are requested. The shoes should be brought to the church sites on September 4th, and September 11th and placed in the marked containers.

If you prefer to make a financial donation to Haiti please write a check to Notre Dame de la Mer parish and in the memo portion of the check please put the word "HAITI". These check donations will be tallied and one check will be sent to the orphanage in Haiti in the name of the parish.

Thank you in advance for taking care of the needs of the least of our brothers and sisters.
