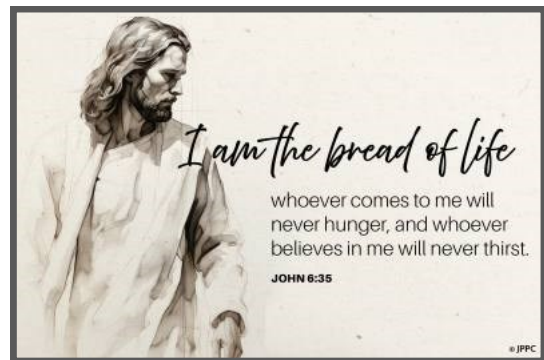

## *From the Desk of Chuck Mirarchi, Ministry Leader*

Hello brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

The Kingdom of Heaven became known to us through Jesus Christ, who is our human image of the unseen creator of the universe. He taught us many things about Heaven. He revealed that His Father has many rooms prepared for us.

In this Letter, I want to share how we can actively take part in the Kingdom of God. We are in the Kingdom when you walk into Adoration, Holy Hour. With the Body of Jesus displayed in the Monstrance we are with the King and the kingdom is where the King is.

We step out of this world and into a different realm right behind that invisible veil, far beyond our understanding. Behind the Monstrance are all our loved ones who have passed on sitting with us. You will forget your problems, anxiety, routines and become emersed in God presence.

### **How can we make this time a rich spiritual experience?**

- Be in His presence and feel His love and mercy. Tell Jesus you love him. Let your emotions come out. Speak silently and plainly to God. Share if you are angry or grateful and why. In silence you will hear.
- Pray the Rosary or Chaplet of Divine Mercy or Stations of the Cross. Prayer, especially Catholic prayer is done in such a way that it puts our minds into a meditative state. It relaxes us and thus breaks down the barriers that block us hearing The Almighty Father.
  - Pray to our Blessed Virgin Mother. Jesus loves his mother. We honor him greatly by respecting his mom. Growing up, my closest friends were those who treated my mom good. That is how Jesus receives us.
- A.C.T.S. - This is a simple thought process for you on how to pray. From Father Wade Menezes. When you pray, pray with these thoughts:
  - A - is for Adoration to the Father Son and Holy Spirit. Tell him you love Him.
  - C - is for the Confession of our sins. Ask God for forgiveness.
  - T - is for Thanksgiving, for every day we have something to be thankful for. It's good to spend a moment thinking about something good in your life, to be thankful for it. Someone always has it worse than you.
  - S - is for Supplications, our intentions, our asking, seeking, knocking to God in Jesus' name. In one way or another you will be answered, you will find, and the door will be opened!
- Read the Gospels. This is a great place to read how Jesus fulfilled in the Gospels, what was hidden in the Old testaments. for example:
  - Genesis 14:18 the bread of life is referenced.
  - Psalm 2 references Jesus coming. "Kiss the Son, lest you perish along the way..."
  - Isaiah 53 foretells Jesus Agony and Passion and Paschal mystery. "He is despised and lowest among men, a man of sorrows who knows infirmity."
  - Psalm 22. Jesus quotes the first verse on the Cross, but it is the ending the Jews recognize. 1<sup>st</sup> Century Jews knew the Old Testament and sang Psalms daily.
- Listen in silence. We can spend time talking with God but be a good listener too. Listen to your own thoughts. Slow your mind down. Do nothing and empty all your worries in the slice of Heaven on earth, present in Adoration. The Kingdom is where the King is, and the Eucharist is the King, therefore we are in the Kingdom of Heaven when we sit in Adoration along with the ever-present Holy Spirit.

This gift of Adoration is front row seats to the Kingdom of Heaven. It is playing at a local Parish near you.

## Readings of the Week

### Reading I : Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15

The Lord provides what we need.

- The people speak of death twice in this passage, which reflects anxiety due to hunger.
- When God provides manna and quail, they ask, "What is this?"
- This all occurred one month after leaving Egypt.

### Reading II : Ephesians 4:17, 20-24

Be renewed in the spirit of your mind; put away your old self.

- The young Church is persuading the people to put away the ways of the world, possibly numerous gods and immorality—much as it is in any society at any time.
- The passage moves back and forth between denunciation and urging.
- The central point is that a radical change is needed.

### Gospel : John 6:24-35

Do not work for food that perishes; work for food that endures for eternal life.

- Jesus appears to be aware that the people are shallow in their commitment.
- The crowd has focused on the sign and failed to believe its message.
- Jesus is the manna, the provision from God to quench spiritual hunger; he is the Bread of Life.

## Family Reflection Corner

- Have the family sit around a table. Play some reflective music. Pass around a loaf of bread. Invite each person to break off a piece of bread, telling them not to eat the bread yet. When everyone has taken a piece of bread, invite them to examine the bread: smell it, feel it, and look closely. Finally, ask them to eat the bread. Ask them to share the results of their examination and what memories and thoughts came to mind as they ate the bread. Do the same with grape juice.
- You are Jesus' hands and feet on this earth. There are many hungry people waiting for help. Have your family help at a food bank or soup kitchen. If possible go as a family to deliver food to a shut-in. Discuss what hunger feels like.
- Discuss what your daily spiritual diet is like. Is it junk food, baby food, frozen food? How have you changed to become a spiritual person who eats healthy food and reflects it as a result? You are what you eat.

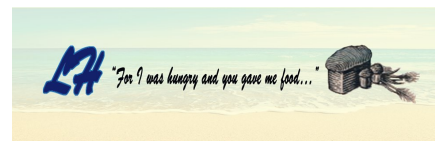

### **John Vianney, Priest, 1786-1859**: This Saint's Feast Day is August 4

John Vianney was born in a village near Lyons, France shortly before the French Revolution. His parents, poor farmers, were devout Catholics and brought up their son to be the same.

John received minimal schooling while working as a shepherd on his family farm, and he longed for more education. From an early age, he developed a desire to become a priest. After years of hard work, John was finally ordained in 1815. Drawing people from the region and beyond, the priest would spend twelve to sixteen hours a day in the confessional rather than turn anyone away. The curé had an insight into the souls of his penitents, and on many occasions, he reminded them of sins that they had forgotten or how many years it had been since their last confession.

John Vianney, who was known as the Curé d'Ars, died on August 4, 1859. Even on his deathbed, he called penitents to him to finish hearing their confessions. St. John Vianney was canonized in 1925 by Pope Pius XI. He is the patron saint of parish priests.
