Letter from AnnaMae Muryasz Parish Activities

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Second Sunday of Advent!

The season of Advent is a time of waiting: waiting to receive our Savior anew into our hearts on Christmas Day. During this wonderful season we also anticipate the beginning of the Year of Mercy declared by Pope Francis. The year of Mercy will begin on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception (December 8, 2015) and end on the Presentation of Mary (November 21, 2016).

After the service there will be refreshments in Kelly Hall.
