#### **Campaign Objectives**

This \$750,000 campaign will build upon the strong legacy of the Notre Dame de la Mer community, so it can continue meeting the needs of parishioners and students for many generations to come.

The campaign objectives will elevate our facilities to better align with the dignity and excellence of the spiritual care and formation we provide. Objectives with estimated individual cost include:

#### **St. Ann**

##### Roof Replacement

Phase I: Exterior Roof Replacement – \$190,000 (currently underway)

Phase II: Interior Ceiling & Wall Repair – \$70,000

Total St. Ann Estimate: \$260,000

#### **Assumption**

##### Replace HVAC System

Phase I: Boiler Replacement – \$95,000

Phase II: 20 Ton Split System (Flanking Alter) – \$184,400

Phase III: 15 Ton Split System (Choir Loft) – \$170,600

##### Retrofit Pendant Lights

Phase I: Completed – Retrofitted Four Lights

Phase II: Retrofit Remaining 20 lights – \$36,000

Phase III: Repair of Choir Loft Electric – \$4,000

Total Assumption Estimate: \$490,000

# Happy Father's Day

TO ALL FATHERS OF THIS PARISH ~ THIS IS FOR YOU ~

In December 2020, Pope Francis' apostolic letter, *Patris Corde* ("With a Father's Heart) described these seven traits of the fatherhood of St. Joseph which can give great insight and inspiration to fathers.

**A beloved father:** Not only did Joseph love Jesus as if he were his own son, but Jesus loved him. Although Jesus understood his father dwelled in heaven, Jesus accepted, loved and appreciated Joseph for the man and the father figure that he was during his time on Earth.

**A tender and loving father:** Attentive, wise and kind, Joseph provided Jesus with every opportunity he could, most notably, passing on to Jesus his carpentry knowledge and work habits. He patiently, lovingly spent much time teaching Jesus a creative trade that they could enjoy and practice together.

**An obedient father:** One could imagine the initial surprise Joseph felt when Mary told him an angel had visited her and the Holy Spirit was to bestow a child, the Son of God, within her. Joseph's faith and obedience to God's Will gave him the grace to accept this astounding situation and then to adapt to and shoulder his awesome husband and parenting responsibilities.

**An accepting father:** Joseph not only accepted God's will, but Jesus himself. He welcomed Jesus into his life. Embracing him as his own son, Joseph willingly took on the role of Jesus' earthly father-figure. He stepped up when he was called to by God. Jesus loved him as His father on earth. And God the Father was well pleased with them both.

**A creatively courageous father:** Joseph's courage is truly admirable. He was faced with so many unexpected situations — he was asked to be a father to a child who was not his; he had to keep Jesus and Mary safe from deadly dangers; he had to move them to a foreign land and sustain them there for years. Yet in all the challenges he encountered, he obeyed God and acted just as a brave, caring, reliable, enterprising and flexible father and husband should act, prioritizing, protecting and loving his family.

**A working father:** Joseph had a model work ethic. Working as if everything depended on him, He toiled hard to do his very best to honor God's Will and to provide for the wellbeing of his family — while ultimately relying on God's Plan and God's love.

**A "father in the shadows":** Pope Francis refers to St. Joseph as a "father in the shadows." In, his relationship to Jesus, Joseph was the earthly "shadow" of the heavenly Father. He watched over Jesus and protected him, being physically and emotionally present for Jesus through good and bad times. He stayed in the shadows because, especially after observing Jesus as an adolescent in the Temple in Jerusalem, ready to hold His own with religious pundits, St. Joseph understood that the most important thing he could do for his son was to let Him focus on doing His Heavenly Father's Will. ~ Like father, like son ~

## Reflections on the Readings

**READING I: Jeremiah 20:10-13 — He has delivered the soul of the needy from the hands of evil men.**

◆ This reading comes from the middle of Jeremiah's prayer and it is the most graphic description of this prophet's struggle. Jeremiah complains to God about the cost of his prophetic call. His complaint is interwoven with expressions of trust in God.

**RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Psalm 69:8-10, 14, 17, 33-35 —The Lord hears the poor.**

◆ There are many forms of poverty: the poverty of those who lack material means of subsistence; moral and spiritual poverty; the poverty of those who are socially marginalized and lack the means to give voice to their dignity and abilities; cultural poverty; the poverty of those who find themselves in conditions of personal or social weakness or fragility; and the poverty of those who lack rights or space or freedom. Popes Francis and Leo XIV recognize all these in *Dilexi Te* ("I Have Loved You").

**READING II: Romans 5:12-15 — God's gift to us is nothing like our sin against Him.**

◆ Paul compares Adam, the first human, to Jesus, the firstborn of the new creation. Death is the result of sin; sin separates us from God who is the source of life. Jesus was obedient to God and therefore became the perfect channel of life for humans.

**GOSPEL: Matthew 10:26-33 — Do not fear those who can kill the body.**

◆ This passage is part of the missionary discourse that follows the sending out of the Twelve. Jesus reminds the fearful, fledgling disciples of the expansiveness of the great and powerful care of the Father. Using the debating device of comparing the lesser to the greater, Jesus stresses that not even a sparrow dies without God's consent.

## Saint of the Week

### SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST

June 24

According to the Gospel of St. Luke, John's parents were named Elizabeth and Zechariah and they were beyond the age for having children. But Zechariah, a priest who served in the Temple in Jerusalem, was told one night by the Archangel Gabriel that Elizabeth would give birth to a boy whom they must name, John. Zechariah was dumbfounded, literally. When he disbelieved this annunciation, he was rendered speechless until the child's birth. When his speech was restored, a torrent of praise poured out in the canticle known as the *Benedictus* which is prayed today as part of the Breviary every day at Morning Prayer by priests and nuns worldwide.

According to Biblical accounts, John's mother was a relative of Jesus' mother, Mary, which makes John the Baptist a cousin of Jesus. The Gospel of St. Luke also records that while pregnant with John, Elizabeth was visited by Mary and, upon Mary's greeting, the unborn John leapt (for joy) in his mother's womb.

St. John the Baptist became a man revered for his holiness and integrity who accepted death rather than swallow his righteous words criticizing the powerful Herod Antipas. He preached and prophesied like Jesus, fasted and prayed like Jesus, and died for the truth like Jesus. But John's ministry was separate and distinct from Jesus' ministry. John's prophetic mission was to preach repentance and "prepare the way" for Jesus. John publicly identified Jesus as the "Lamb of God," baptized Him, and humbly declared himself not worthy to stoop down and untie the straps of Jesus' sandals.

The celebration of the nativity of John the Baptist may be the oldest liturgical feast day in Christendom, much older even than the Feast of Christmas. The commemoration of the Passion (beheading) of John on August 29 is of equally ancient origin.
