Campaign Objectives

This \$750,000 campaign will build upon the strong legacy of the Notre Dame de la Mer community, so it can continue meeting the needs of parishioners and students for many generations to come.

The campaign objectives will elevate our facilities to better align with the dignity and excellence of the spiritual care and formation we provide. Objectives with estimated individual cost include:

Roof Replacement

Phase I: Exterior Roof Replacement – \$190,000 (currently underway)

Phase II: Interior Ceiling & Wall Repair – \$70,000

Total St. Ann Estimate: \$260,000

Assumption

Replace HVAC System

Phase I: Boiler Replacement – \$95,000

Phase II: 20 Ton Split System (Flanking Altar) – \$184,400

Phase III: 15 Ton Split System (Choir Loft) – \$170,600

Retrofit Pendant Lights

Phase I: Completed – Retrofitted Four Lights

Phase II: Retrofit Remaining 20 lights – \$36,000

Phase III: Repair of Choir Loft Electric – \$4,000

Total Assumption Estimate: \$490,000

Feast of Saints Peter and Paul ~ June 29



THE CATHOLIC CHURCH CELEBRATES THE FEAST OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL ON JUNE 29. THE FEAST IS A CELEBRATION OF HOW JESUS MIRACULOUSLY USED THE STRONG FAITH, MINISTRY AND MISSION OF EACH OF THESE APOSTLES TO FORM THE LASTING FOUNDATIONS OF THE UNIVERSAL CATHOLIC CHURCH IN ROME. SAINTS PETER AND PAUL ARE THE PATRON SAINTS OF THE CITY OF ROME.

Saint Peter's Strong Testimony of Faith

When Jesus questioned his disciples on what public opinion thought of Him, it was Peter who ultimately testified to his faith in the Divinity of Jesus, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus' response is to declare Peter the "rock" on which He would build the Church, assuring him that "the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it" (*Matthew 16: 13-19*). This scripture passage is cited in support of Jesus' intention that Peter exercise leadership in the Church.

Saint Paul's Strong Testimony of Faith

At the end of his life, Paul testified to his steadfast faith in Jesus that sustained his mission to non-Jewish peoples: "I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith....The Lord stood by me and gave me strength, so that through me the proclamation might be completed and all the Gentiles might hear it" (*2 Timothy 4:7, 17*).

Saint Peter's Leadership from Rome

Jesus promised to give Peter the "keys to the Kingdom of Heaven," an image associated with successor Popes to this day (*Matthew 16:19*). This promise to Peter, along with biblical passages making it clear that Peter exercised leadership not only for the Christian congregation in Rome but for congregations outside of Rome, are cited in support of Jesus' intention that leadership in the Church should emanate from Rome and be exercised by Peter and successors of Peter, nowadays, the "Bishop of Rome," the "Pope." (*Acts 1:15-22, 2:14-41, 3:1-12, 4:1-22, 5:1-11, 15:1-11*).

The Martyrdom and Burial of Saints Peter and Paul in Rome

The great Saint Irenaeus discerned this intent of Jesus in the fact that both Peter and Paul were martyred in Rome. He wrote, in the late second century, that Rome is "the greatest and most ancient Church, founded by the two glorious Apostles, Peter and Paul." No other city could claim to be the seat of two martyred Apostles or built over the bones of an Apostle. Rome's headship over all the churches is rooted most deeply in the martyrdoms in the eternal city of Saints Peter and Paul. St. Irenaeus' feast day is celebrated June 28, the day before the feast day of Saints Peter and Paul.

Rome, the two-Apostle city, draws large numbers of pilgrims to the tombs of both Saint Peter and Saint Paul. If a plumb line were dropped hundreds of feet from the apex of the dome of St. Peter's Basilica, it would come to rest directly over the tomb of Saint Peter in the necropolis below the Basilica's main altar. A few miles away, under the main altar of the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, lies the mortal remains of the great Apostle to the Gentiles. The inscription naming Saint Paul on an ancient marble cover for his tomb leaves no doubt whose bones were placed there.

The Roman Catholic Church Is a Miracle

The Roman Catholic Church is a miracle: theologically perfect but humanly flawed; mystical and historical; reflecting humanity—capable of so much good, yet limited by sinfulness and imperfections. A perfect God started building His Church upon the "rock" of the faith, ministry and mission of Saints Peter and Paul, two different, impressive, and imperfect men—and Jesus assured us that the gates of hell would not prevail against their efforts and His Roman Catholic Church.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: 2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16a — Elisha is a holy man of God, let him stay with us.

◆ A Shunemite woman of influence recognized Elisha as a holy man of God and she urged him to dine and stay with her and her husband. To return her kindness and generosity, Elisha promises her that she will give birth to a son. She is a beautiful example of how to receive both a prophet and the prophetic word, with openness and an eager welcome.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Psalm 89:2-3, 16-17, 18-19 — David's dynasty is to be as long-lasting as the heavens.

◆ Joy and rejoicing are for people who walk in God's protective sight, faithfulness, kindness, and justice in favor of their King David. God is their source of strength; their military wins a sign of God's favor. King David praises God, humbly acknowledging that his and his peoples' victories, strength and shield—and his very self (kingship)—belong to God.

READING II: Romans 6:3-4, 8-11 — Buried with Christ in baptism, we shall walk in the newness of life.

◆ We who were baptized into Christ have been baptized into Christ's Death. We no longer need to fear death. Sin and death no longer hold any power over us. We are to live for God!

GOSPEL: Matthew 10:37-42 — Whoever does not take up his cross is not worthy of me. Whoever receives you, receives me.

◆ Jesus explains the demands of discipleship. Those who welcome disciples welcome Jesus himself. They will be rewarded. Disciples are also included among the "little ones." Those who welcome them will also be rewarded.

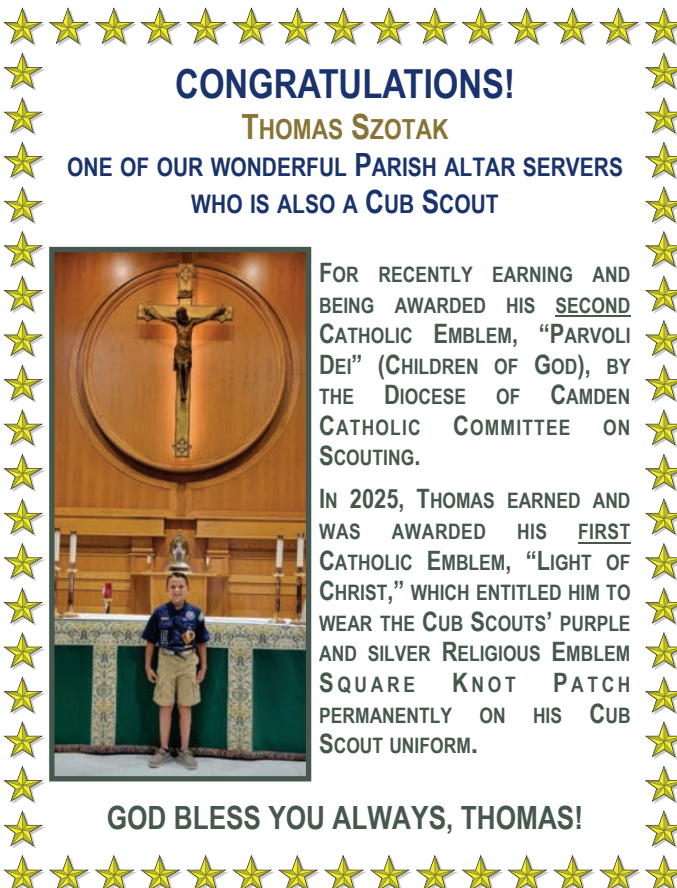

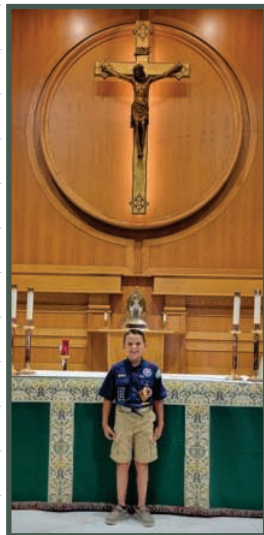


