Campaign Objectives

This \$750,000 campaign will build upon the strong legacy of the Notre Dame de la Mer community, so it can continue meeting the needs of parishioners and students for many generations to come.

The campaign objectives will elevate our facilities to better align with the dignity and excellence of the spiritual care and formation we provide. Objectives with estimated individual cost include:

Roof Replacement

Phase I: Exterior Roof Replacement – \$190,000 (currently underway)

Phase II: Interior Ceiling & Wall Repair – \$70,000

Total St. Ann Estimate: \$260,000

Assumption

Replace HVAC System

Phase I: Boiler Replacement – \$95,000

Phase II: 20 Ton Split System (Flanking Altar) – \$184,400

Phase III: 15 Ton Split System (Choir Loft) – \$170,600

Retrofit Pendant Lights

Phase I: Completed – Retrofitted Four Lights

Phase II: Retrofit Remaining 20 lights – \$36,000

Phase III: Repair of Choir Loft Electric – \$4,000

Total Assumption Estimate: \$490,000

Saint of the Week

St. Maria Goretti
1890-1902

Maria Goretti's family was poor. After her father died of malaria, the family was forced to share a modest home with another family and her mother had to work the fields with her children. Maria stayed home to cook, clean, sew, and care for her baby sister. One day, while she was mending a shirt of Alessandro, the teenage boy of the family that shared the house, he attacked Maria. It was not the first time he had imposed himself on 11-year-old Maria. And it was not the first time she had refused. She tried to stop him again. She screamed that it was a mortal sin and that he would go to hell. Alessandro didn't stop this time. She ran for the door, but he stabbed her in the throat, heart, and lungs. Maria was brought to the hospital where doctors tried in vain to save her life. Before dying, she revealed to her mother and the police that Alessandro had tried to rape her twice before. Since he had threatened her with death if she told anyone, she had kept silent. Before dying, Maria forgave her attacker and said she wanted him to, one day, be with her in paradise. Maria was canonized in 1950 by Pope Pius XII. After initially refusing to communicate with anyone about the murder, Alessandro opened up to a local bishop who took the time to visit him in jail. Alessandro told the bishop he had a dream in which Maria presented him with lilies, symbols of purity, but the flowers scorched his hands as soon as he touched them. He later asked Maria's mother for forgiveness and, like her daughter, she forgave him. Alessandro served 27 years of his 30-year sentence. After being released, he became a lay Franciscan and served as a gardener in a monastery until his death.

Saint Maria Goretti is the patron saint of rape victims and teenage girls. Her feast day is July 6.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Zechariah 9:9-10 — Shout for joy! He comes in peace.

◆ The verses in this reading describe the messianic king in terms familiar to the tradition. Jerusalem was personified as a sentinel waiting for the king's arrival. The new messiah, who came like Solomon, would banish all instruments of war; his kingdom would be a kingdom of peace.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Psalm 145:1-2, 8-9, 10-11, 13-14 — D.

◆ The psalmist is inviting all to praise God, extolling His might as well as His goodness and kindness. God's mighty acts are described as evidence of His divine kingship, a theme in early Judaic writing. [In Hebrew, every verse of Psalm 145, from which this Responsorial Psalm is taken, begins with a successive letter of the alphabet.]

READING II: Romans 8:9, 11-13 — Live by the Spirit.

◆ The Letter to the Romans describes the activity of God's Spirit. Paul uses the image of flesh without spirit to describe the person who does not live by God's Spirit. According to Paul, that "Spirit-less" person is already dead.

GOSPEL: Matthew 11:25-30 — Come to me all you who are weary.

◆ Jesus speaks, not only as a wisdom teacher, but as Wisdom herself. Jesus borrows the language of wisdom to praise God for revelation through Him. He is the perfect revelation of God because Jesus is God's Son, knowing God perfectly.

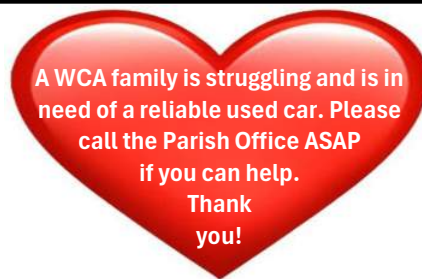




