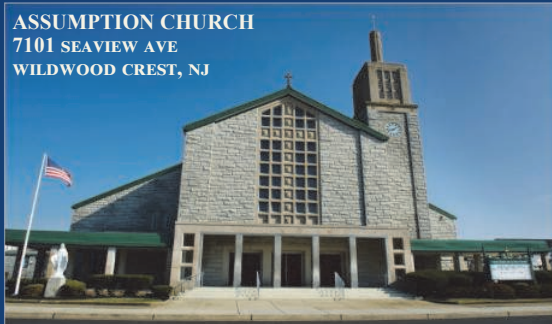

We are all blessed to have such beautiful churches and after many wonderful years of worship, prayer, and the sacraments, are now asking for help to address three immediate concerns (identified below). The years have taken a toll on many parts of both our churches, and this campaign is asking for assistance with the most urgent needs to enable Notre Dame de la Mer to continue to provide a comfortable and beautiful environment.

Campaign Objectives

This \$750,000 campaign will build upon the strong legacy of the Notre Dame de la Mer community, so it can continue meeting the needs of parishioners and students for many generations to come.

The campaign objectives will elevate our facilities to better align with the dignity and excellence of the spiritual care and formation we provide. Objectives with estimated individual cost include:

- **St. Ann**
 - Roof Replacement (project currently underway)
 - ✦ Phase I: Exterior Roof Replacement – \$190,000
 - ✦ Phase II: Interior Ceiling & Wall Repair – \$70,000
 - ✦ **Total St. Ann Estimate: \$260,000**
- ✦ **Assumption**
 - Replace HVAC System
 - ✦ Phase I: Boiler Replacement – \$95,000
 - ✦ Phase II: 20 Ton Split System (Flanking Altar) – \$184,400
 - ✦ Phase III: 15 Ton Split System (Choir Loft) – \$170,600
 - ✦ Retrofit Pendant Lights
 - ✦ *Phase I: Completed – Retrofitted Four Lights*
 - ✦ Phase II: Retrofit Remaining 20 lights – \$36,000
 - ✦ Phase III: Repair of Choir loft Electric – \$4,000
 - ✦ **Total Assumption Estimate: \$490,000**

Saint of the Week

St. Mary Magdalene First Century

Mary Magdalene was present at important Gospel events: the Passion, the crucifixion, the burial, and, in a garden, for the Resurrection. She opens the door to scenes that would otherwise remain hidden from view.

Mary Magdalene was among a group of women who congregated at the outer edge of the twelve Apostles. These were probably women of means, who "provided for" Jesus and the Apostles "out of their resources" (Lk 8:3). When these women are named, Mary Magdalene is always named first. She is named many more times in the Gospels than most of the Apostles themselves, signaling her importance.

The Gospel of Luke relates that seven demons were driven from her (Lk 8:2). There is debate over whether Mary Magdalene is also the sinful woman who anoints Christ's feet and if she is also Mary of Bethany, the sister of Martha and Lazarus. Building on a presumption that she was that sinful woman, medieval tradition wrongly described her as a repentant prostitute. Despite the dubious connection between Mary Magdalene and prostitution, this association continues today and will likely take centuries to purify. Mary was a common Jewish name. Magdala was a town on the Sea of Galilee. So when "Mary from Magdala" is used in the New Testament, it is to distinguish her from other Marys.

An old Christian tradition refers to Mary Magdalene as the "Apostle to the Apostles." The resurrected Jesus appeared to her first: Mary and other women go to His tomb to anoint His body. They see the stone rolled away and enter. The body is not there. An angel tells them to not be afraid, "But go, tell his disciples and Peter" (Mk 16:7; Jn 20:1-2). Mary dutifully fulfills the angelic orders. It is a woman, then, who tells the men, who spreads the news of all news to everyone else. The men come running and verify her account. The tomb is empty. She weeps outside the tomb while Peter and John are inside. Time passes as they try to absorb what this all means until, finally, the "disciples returned to their homes" (Jn 20:10). But Mary does not go home.

And then it happens: Mary is alone again, crying. She just can't believe it. She has to take another look. So she bends her body in half to peer into the low empty tomb once again. When she straightens up, she notices a man standing just behind her. She thinks he is a gardener. A short, awkward conversation follows and then abruptly concludes: "Mary!" "Rabbi!" (Jn 20:16). Her name is in the mouth of the risen Christ!

St. Mary Magdalene is the patron saint of converts, hairdressers and perfumers. Her feast day is July 22.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Wisdom 12:13, 16-19 — Your might is the source of justice.

♦ The lesson for God's people in this reading from the Book of Wisdom is twofold: As God is merciful, so should the people be merciful to those who offend them. Because God is merciful, the people may live in hope that God will forgive their sins.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Psalm 86:5-6, 9-10, 15-16 — A good and forgiving God hears prayer.

♦ This psalm is a prayer of individual lament. It is a prayer for strength and protection, with praise for and reliance upon the goodness, forgiveness, kindness, greatness, mercy, graciousness, attentiveness and pity of God towards "your servant."

READING II: Romans 8:26-27 — The Spirit helps us pray.

♦ Paul continues his proclamation of the power of God's Spirit. It is God's Spirit who understands and is divine Wisdom. The Spirit knows us better than we know ourselves. The Spirit helps us convey to God what we feel in our hearts. The Spirit pleads on our behalf for what we truly need and for what is in accordance with God's Will and plan for each Christian's life.

GOSPEL: Matthew 13:24-43 — The Reign of God is among us.

♦ The parables make the point that the Kingdom of God may look small in Jesus' ministry and preaching, but its growth will be rapid and thorough. The parable of the weeds in the wheat means that good and bad cannot be separated without harming the good. God's people must trust Divine Wisdom as they co-exist with and face evil in the world.

An independent, toll-free number has been established by the Diocese of Camden to help callers report cases of sexual abuse by priests, deacons, religious, employees and/or volunteers. Calls are handled by a licensed clinical social worker. In accord with state law, cases of child sexual abuse are reported to the N.J. Division of Child Protection and Permanency and law enforcement.
