Refurbishment & Revitalize Campaign

Thank you for being a part of Notre Dame de la Mer Catholic Community and for supporting the work of the Church with your time, talent, and treasure. Your presence and your contributions are a true blessing.

We are all blessed to have such beautiful churches and after many wonderful years of worship, prayer, and the sacraments, are now asking for help to address three immediate concerns (identified below). Campaign Objectives

This \$750,000 campaign will build upon the strong legacy of the Notre Dame de la Mer community, so it can continue meeting the needs of parishioners and students for many generations to come.

The campaign objectives will elevate our facilities to better align with the dignity and excellence of the spiritual care and formation we provide. Objectives with estimated individual cost include:

St. Ann

- Roof Replacement (project currently underway)
 - ❖ Phase I: Exterior Roof Replacement – \$190,000
 - ❖ Phase II: Interior Ceiling & Wall Repair – \$70,000
- Total St. Ann Estimate: \$260,000**

Assumption

- Replace HVAC System
 - ❖ Phase I: Boiler Replacement – \$95,000
 - ❖ Phase II: 20 Ton Split System (Flanking Altar) – \$184,400
 - ❖ Phase III: 15 Ton Split System (Choir Loft) – \$170,600
 - ❖ Retrofit Pendant Lights
 - ❖ Phase I: Completed – Retrofitted Four Lights
 - ❖ Phase II: Retrofit Remaining 20 lights – \$36,000
 - ❖ Phase III: Repair of Choir loft Electric – \$4,000

Total Assumption Estimate: \$490,000

Saint of the Week

Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr, d. c. 258

Lawrence was appointed a deacon under Pope Saint Sixtus II. It was Lawrence's job to handle the treasury, distribute alms to the poor, and take care of the sick, of which more than 1,000 were under the care of the Church at this time.

In 257, Emperor Valerian issued an edict against all Christians. A year later, Pope Sixtus was arrested and led off to be executed. It is written that Lawrence followed the Pope, weeping, and asked him, "Father, where are you going without your deacon?" The pope replied, "I do not leave you my son. You shall soon follow me." Lawrence was overjoyed to think that God would soon call him.

The deacon set out to find all of the poor, the widows, the orphans, and all others whom the Church had been caring for. He distributed to them all of the money which he had and even sold the chalices and other sacred vessels of the Church in order to increase the amount which he could give to the unfortunates.

The prefect of Rome, hearing of Lawrence's charities and assuming even greater wealth, sent for Lawrence and demanded that the treasures of the Church be handed over to him. Lawrence promised that he would hand over these treasures, but needed time to assemble and inventory them. He was granted three days.

On the third day, Lawrence had assembled hundreds of poor, the old, the lame, the blind, lepers, widows and orphans. Then, going to the prefect, he presented these as the treasures of the Church. The prefect failed to see the humor in this, and sentenced Lawrence to death. Knowing that Lawrence had no fear of death, he ordered a large grill to be constructed and placed over hot coals so that Lawrence would die a slow and painful death.

When Lawrence had been on the grill for some time, apparently feeling no pain, he is said to have told his persecutors, "You can turn me over now; I'm done on this side."

After his death, his great faith, witnessed by many Roman officials, led to the immediate conversion of several Romansenators who took up his body and buried it on the Via Tiburtina. There, a church was later built in his honor. Saint Lawrence is the patron of Rome, of the poor, and, perhaps with a hint of his own humor, cooks.

We honor Lawrence on August 10 by a feast. Lawrence's message today: We sometimes have a tendency to take ourselves too seriously, and forget that God has the ultimate sense of humor. We too are blessed with this gift, and should manage the sufferings which we experience with the best possible grace.

Are you able to use a bit of humor when navigating through life's trials?

Reflections on the Readings

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reading I : 1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a - The Lord will be passing by.

The reading from Kings refers to a time after the death of King Solomon, when the Israelite kingdom was split in two. Elijah confronts the unfaithfulness of the people and their leaders.

God comes to Elijah in the stillness of silence.

Reading II : Romans 9:1-5 - I speak the truth in Christ

In the letter to the Romans, Paul declares the revelation of God in the Israelites.

The Messiah, God's fullest revelation, came into the world through them.

Paul is grieved that so many of the Israelites refuse to accept Jesus.

Gospel : Matthew 14:22-33 - Lord, save me!

The story of Peter walking on the water is found only in the Gospel of Matthew.

Peter is being prepared for his role as leader. He begins to sink when he takes his eyes off Jesus.

The presence of God in Christ is Peter's strength.

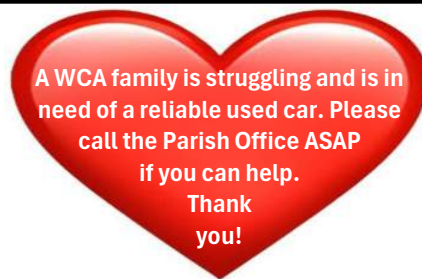

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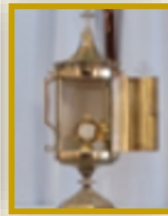
