Dear Parishioners,

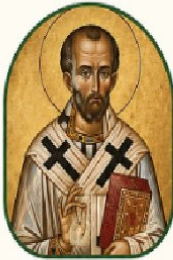

Saint of the Week & Reflections on Readings

Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time



John Chrysostom,
Bishop and Doctor
c. 347–407



EARLY LIFE

Born the son of a military officer, John was well educated and was baptized in 369. He wanted to live as a monk, and in 374 he became a hermit under Saint Basil. Poor health forced him to return home.



PRIEST AND PREACHER

John was ordained a priest in 386 and served in Antioch for twelve years. He became famous for his powerful preaching and love of justice and the poor. People gave him the name "Chrysostom," meaning "golden mouth."



BISHOP OF CONSTANTINOPLE

In 398, John was made Archbishop of Constantinople. He lived simply and used church money to help the poor and support hospitals. His sermons against greed and wrongdoing made many powerful enemies.



EXILE AND RETURN

In 403, John was falsely accused and exiled by order of the emperor. After an earthquake and public pressure, he was allowed to return. But his criticism of the empress led to a second exile in 404, where he died in 407.



PATRON SAINT

Saint John Chrysostom is the patron saint of preachers and orators. We celebrate his memorial on **September 13**.



REFLECTION

John spoke out against injustice, even when it cost him. Do you speak up for what is right? Do you challenge unfairness in your words or actions?

Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reading I: [Sirach 27:30-28:7](#)

- ❖ Forgive your neighbor's faults, and when you pray, your sins will be forgiven.
- ❖ The Book of Sirach is concerned with anger and quarreling.
- ❖ If we refuse to forgive, then who will forgive us?
- ❖ Refusal is a deliberate choice and it shapes a sinner's life.

Reading II: [Romans 14:7-9](#)

- ❖ Whether alive or dead, we belong to the Lord.
- ❖ We belong to God, not to ourselves.
- ❖ We live not be our own power, but by the creative power of God and the mercy given us through Christ's Resurrection.
- ❖ We have no right to judge one another.
- ❖ Judgment belongs to God alone. By God's mercy we have been granted the power to forgive.

Gospel: [Matthew 18:21-35](#)

- ❖ I did not say to forgive seven times but seventy times seven.
- ❖ Vengeance must not be multiplied, but instead forgiveness should be multiplied.
- ❖ God is forgiving; we are made in God's image.
- ❖ God will judge us by the measure of our forgiveness of one another.
- ❖ Our mutual forgiveness will reveal how the image of God lives in us.
