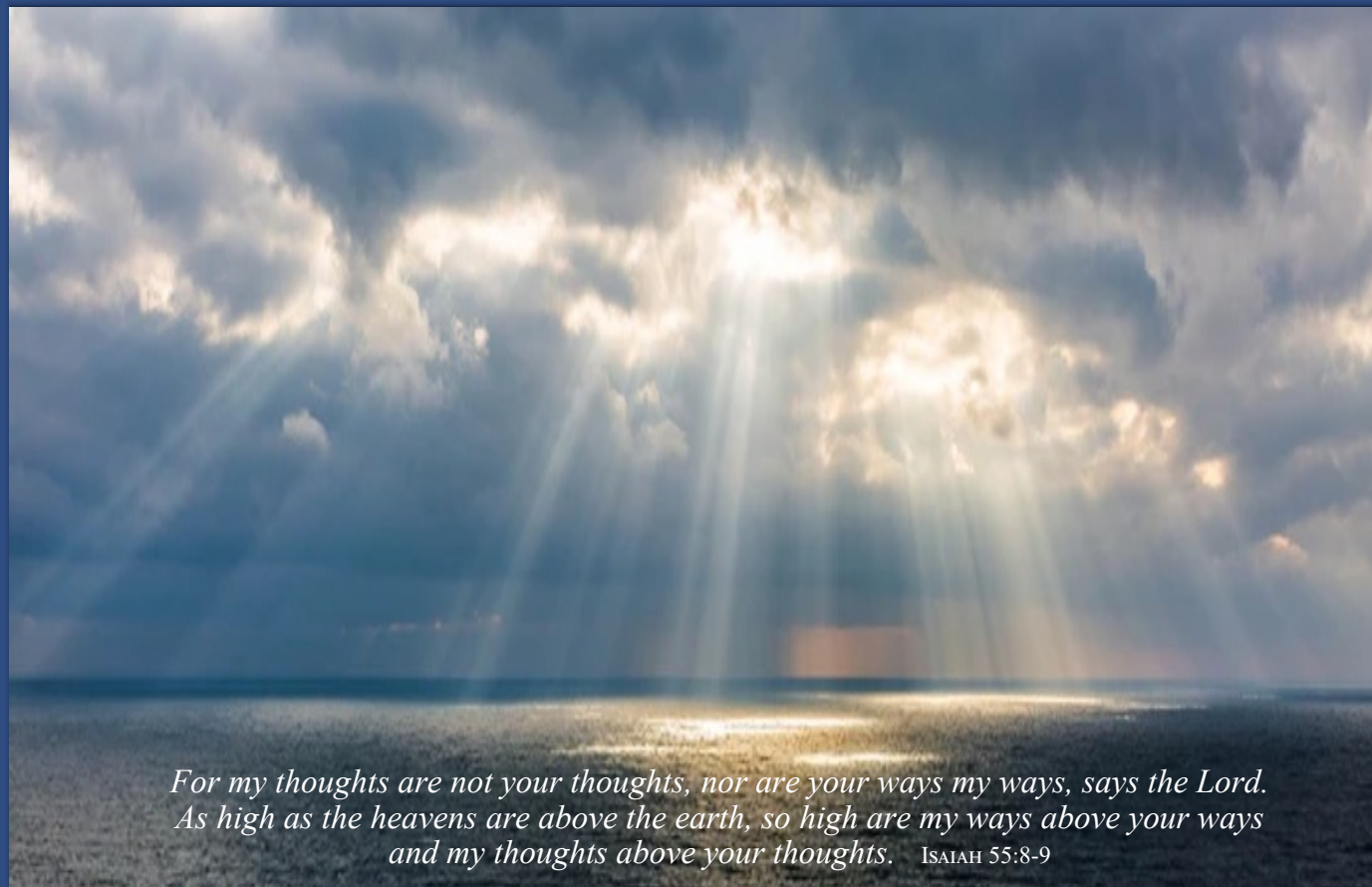

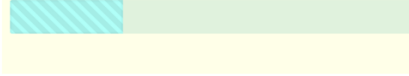

For many people, Notre Dame de la Mer Parish is part of what makes the shore special. We come here for the ocean, the boardwalk, family traditions and summer memories. We leave with shells tucked into bags, photographs on our phones and, inevitably, a little Wildwood sand still hiding in our shoes. BUT PERHAPS WE SHOULD THINK ABOUT LEAVING A LITTLE SOMETHING BEHIND.

My relationship with the Parish did not begin when my wife and I became full-time residents six years ago. For nearly 40 years prior, my family came to the shore as family staying with family who resided here. We worshipped at St. Ann and Assumption Church, and gradually made the Parish part of our family's life and memories. For the last six years, we have been blessed to call the shore our full-time home, and many parishioners and neighbors, close friends, which we will always have and cherish.

During my work on the "Sacramental Squares" project for the Parish, I was especially reminded that generations before us prayed here, worshipped here, celebrated the Sacraments here — and sacrificed to build and preserve the parish's sacred places of worship so they would be waiting for us when we needed them. That is why the Parish's refurbishment & revitalization campaign, "For Generations to Come," speaks to me so personally. I LOVE THIS PARISH. WHAT HAPPENS HERE MATTERS TO ME.

Our beautiful Parish has real needs. Years of worship, prayer and the Sacraments—and simply the passage of time—inevitably take their toll. Preserving what has been passed on and entrusted to us requires more than affection towards the church buildings. It requires action and sometimes sacrifice, just as it did for those who came before us.

Young Adult Ministry

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Isaiah 55:6-9 — Seek the Lord while he may be found.

♦ God's justice is measured by the demands of mercy. The prophet tells God's people in exile that a return to their land is possible. Only in faith would the people be able to seek the Lord and turn from their evil ways.

READING II: Philippians 1:20c-24, 27a — To me, life means Christ.

♦ The Letter to the Philippians was written when Paul was imprisoned. Paul asks the Philippians to imitate Christ. Even in prison Paul was willing to continue working in the vineyard, knowing that his reward would be far greater than he could imagine.

GOSPEL: Matthew 20:1-16a — The parable of the vineyard.

♦ Throughout the Gospel of Matthew, the author gives new interpretations to Jewish laws. Today's parable shows the power and generosity of God, along with the need for human willingness. Jesus' parable teaches that God is merciful to all.

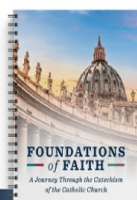

Saint of the Week

**St. Pio of Pietrelcina (Padre Pio)
1887-1968**

Padre Pio grew up poor in the village of Pietrelcina near Naples, Italy. Neither his parents nor his grandparents could read or write. He was baptized as Francesco and worked on the family's small plot of land as a boy. The family was deeply religious. When Francesco was about ten years old, he decided to dedicate his life to God as a Franciscan friar. After completing some schooling and being privately tutored, he entered a nearby Franciscan friary at age fifteen. He took the name Pio (Pius) after a saint honored in his hometown. In 1910, he was ordained a priest in the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin, called Capuchin Franciscans.

Padre Pio lived virtually his entire priestly life at a modest Franciscan friary in the rural town of San Giovanni Rotondo. Beginning in 1918, he began to experience the stigmata—the marks of the sufferings of Christ. He bled where Christ bled. Holes perforated his hands. He had sharp pains in his side. He also began to display supernatural gifts: prophecy, healings, bilocation, and miracles. His personal routine of prayer and mortification was awe-inspiring and mystical.

Padre Pio became famous throughout Italy for being holy and humble and wise. He eventually became widely known and revered throughout the world. By the time of his death in 1968, Padre Pio was a Catholic superstar. People flocked to witness him say long, intense, devotional Masses. Many sought his wise counsel in the confessional.

Padre Pio was totally authentic, totally sincere, and totally holy. Jesus Christ inhabited every corner of his mind, soul, and imagination. His life fused with Christ's so totally that Padre Pio's very body bore the marks of his beloved Savior.

St. Pio of Pietrelcina was canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2002. He is the patron saint of civil defense volunteers and adolescents, and his home town of Pietrelcina. His feast day is September 23.

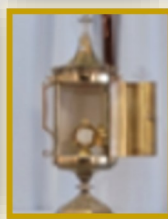

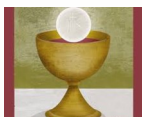
