Campaign Objectives

This \$750,000 campaign will build upon the strong legacy of the Notre Dame de la Mer community, so it can continue meeting the needs of parishioners and students for many generations to come. The campaign objectives will elevate our facilities to better align with the dignity and excellence of the spiritual care and formation we provide. Objectives with estimated individual cost include:

Roof Replacement

Phase I: Exterior Roof Replacement – \$190,000 (currently underway)

Phase II: Interior Ceiling & Wall Repair – \$70,000

Total St. Ann Estimate: \$260,000

Assumption

Replace HVAC System

Phase I: Boiler Replacement – \$95,000

Phase II: 20 Ton Split System (Flanking Altar) – \$184,400

Phase III: 15 Ton Split System (Choir Loft) – \$170,600

Retrofit Pendant Lights

Phase I: Completed – Retrofitted Four Lights

Phase II: Retrofit Remaining 20 lights – \$36,000

Phase III: Repair of Choir Loft Electric – \$4,000

Total Assumption Estimate: \$490,000

From Rev. Christopher Myers, Parochial Vicar

Dear Parishioners & Friends,

I think one could argue that the action that makes us most human is asking, "Why?" I want to show that while asking the question 'why' helps us understand the causes of things, it also leads to something deeper in our spiritual life.

Everyone seeks to find the cause when they ask the question, "Why?" My nieces and nephews always ask my brother and sister that question, and mostly at inopportune moments! Children in elementary school ask their parents and guardians why the crossing guard wears bright colors. Teenagers ask their parents why their curfew is at ten o'clock. College students ask their professors why their research papers must be double-spaced. The point is that it is a question humans frequently ask about the people and environment around them. And "Why?" is a question humans frequently ask God.

Today's Gospel tells us that the disciples asked Jesus "Why do you speak to them in parables?" They had just heard Jesus tell the Parable of the Sower to a crowd of listeners — like us, gathered at the seaside. The answer Jesus gave to his disciples shows His love for them and us. It shows how He longs that those who hear His Word not simply listen superficially. He wants us to take time, without distractions, to ponder His Word with an open heart and with faith in God. If we do that, we will come to understand how profound it is -- Jesus is lovingly using parables to speak directly to us and our circumstances.

We can sincerely ask Jesus "Why?" and expect that He will answer with the insights we need to deepen our faith and increase our love for God and for others. God's Word can convert us, and God can and will heal us. Best of all, God can choose us to bear much fruit in spreading His Word – perhaps along our own seashore.

*You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit
and that your fruit should abide; so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.*

Saint of the Week

St. Kateri Tekakwitha

1656-1680

Kateri (Iroquois for "Catherine") Tekakwitha lived a short life of twenty-four years. Her father was a Mohawk Chief and her mother a Christian Algonquin. Her younger brother and both of her parents died in a smallpox epidemic which damaged young Kateri's vision and scarred her face. She was raised by an aunt and an uncle who was the Chief of the Turtle Clan. She was shy, perhaps because of her impaired vision and facial scars. She quietly listened carefully to the "Black Robes," the Jesuit missionaries who visited the tribe and taught about Jesus Christ and the Catholic religion. Kateri paid close attention to what they were saying and to their religious lifestyle.

At the age of 18, Kateri refusing an arranged marriage and approached the Jesuit Father Jacques de Lamberville to request Baptism. He guided her through the Catechism, and after a few months she told him, "I have deliberated enough. For a long time my decision on what I will do has been made. I have consecrated myself entirely to Jesus, son of Mary, I have chosen Him for husband and He alone will take me for wife." She was baptized in honor of Saint Catherine of Siena on Easter Sunday in 1676.

Soon after her baptism, encountering some resistance from her fellow Mohawks, Kateri left her tribal home in upstate New York and crossed into what is Canada today to live in a traditional Iroquois settlement inhabited by Iroquois Catholics. The inhabitants sought to merge their Indian culture and way of life with their new-found religion. The Jesuits served these Catholic Iroquois. A 1682 letter of one of the Jesuit priests vividly describes life in the settlement and specifically mentions, but leaves unnamed, a young female Mohawk convert of extraordinary piety. It was Kateri.

Kateri and a group of Mohawk women practiced fervent Catholic piety with an emphasis on voluntary suffering. They wanted to emulate the sufferings of Christ, to atone for sins, and to mortify themselves. They wore hair shirts and put on belts with small metal spikes. They stood in ice water while praying the Rosary. Bearing pain, publicly, was part of their Indian culture and religion — and Catholicism's theology and austere religious practices of atonement and mortification melded perfectly.

Kateri was devoted to the Holy Eucharist and to Mary. She was reserved and a contemplative by nature. She delighted in nature's beauty—in trees, birds, and wildflowers—and gathered bouquets of flowers to decorate the altar for Mass. She died with the words "Jesus, Mary, I love you" on her lips. Minutes after her death the people at her bedside noticed that the scars on her face were slowly repaired, and her skin became pure, smooth and beautiful.

St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the patron saint of Canada and orphans. Her feast day is July 14.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Isaiah 55:10-11 — My word shall accomplish my will.

♦ The prophet Isaiah tells us that God's word is effective. Just as the rain does not stop before it has fallen to water the earth, so God's word achieves the end for which God sent it. The word of God is life-giving.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Psalms 65:10, 11, 12-13, 14 — A rich harvest and large flocks are signs of God's bounty.

♦ At God's touch the earth comes alive with vegetation and flocks. This psalm depicts the agricultural year, beginning with the first fall rains that soften the hard sun-baked soil.

READING II: Romans 8:18-23 — We bear our suffering in light of Christ.

♦ This reading speaks of the promised harvest of God's word in people and in all creation. Human beings have not yet arrived at the fullness of their creation, becoming children of God. Paul's letter stresses that at the end, all creation will arrive at its fullness and God's word will have achieved the end for which God sent it.

GOSPEL: Matthew 13: 1-23 — A sower went out to sow.

♦ In the parable of the sower, Jesus was talking about the Kingdom of God. The seed is the word of God; the various kinds of soil represent different dispositions in the hearers. The growth is still growth of the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom of God grows best in willing hearts.

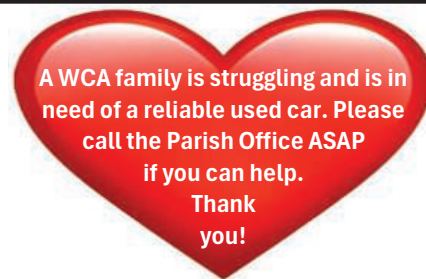

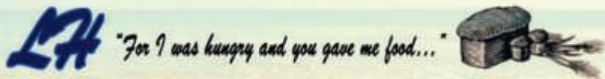
