# Letter From Father Yvans Jazon



## THIS LITTLE LIGHT OF MINE, I am GONNA LET IT SHINE...



I want to start by thanking all of you for your prayers and your support for our Hand-to-Hand Mission to Haiti mission trip 2018 which allowed God's light to shine through nineteen missionaries to the Haitian children and families. Everyone who took sacrificed to serve on this mission was spiritually grounded and felt very blessed to be called by God to make this journey. They felt that they became the extended hands of Jesus to reach out to thousands of brothers and sisters in a different part of the world. This year we had three new people who joined the mission team for the first time. Everyone else has been to Haiti at least once with our mission and two of us since after the earthquake in 2010. Some of you have seen some pictures on Facebook, so you have a sense of how great our experience was there. This year we reach out to more than four thousand (4000) children and elderly people in the villages of Tavette and Cayes-Jacmel. Based on many testimonies that I've heard from the missionaries, they had a great experience and they were showered by much love from the Haitian children during the visits into the communities and schools.

This Sunday's gospel teaches us how Jesus went to some villages to preach the gospel. Through his preaching, many people received healings and were comforted by his presence. Taking the responsibilities of our Christian faith, Hand-to-Hand Mission to Haiti missionaries went to some villages to spread the gospel with love and respect for human dignity, as described in the Catholic social teaching. For the past eight years, we visited so many schools and communities and we are finding some of the children we met during our first mission trip have grown up and are now ready for college. The most significant part of our mission trip is to promote education as the key to success and to encourage the children to stay in school by giving them proper tools to study with, which is why we give them school supplies and the solar light. We witnessed where two of the smaller schools which we added to our distribution sites over the past two years have almost doubled with students and had to build on more classrooms. The children were so grateful and felt so blessed with our distribution of 3000 solar lights and 2000 cinch bags filled with school supplies! This was only possible because many of you helped the Hand-to-Hand Mission to Haiti team in various ways. Some of you donated school supplies or sponsored the solar lanterns, some were there to help us to pack the boxes for international shipping or drove boxes to the New York shipper, some of you helped us to sort the school supplies, some came to our pasta dinner, and some of you prayed and continue to pray for us. So on behalf of Hand-to-Hand Mission to Haiti team we extend great appreciation to the Wildwood Catholic High School and each one of you, students, parishioners, or sponsors who supported us and made this great mission happen.

We thank our pastor, Fr. Joseph Wallace, who has been a tremendous support to this mission which he experienced firsthand two years ago.

May God continue to bless you all and be with you always,
